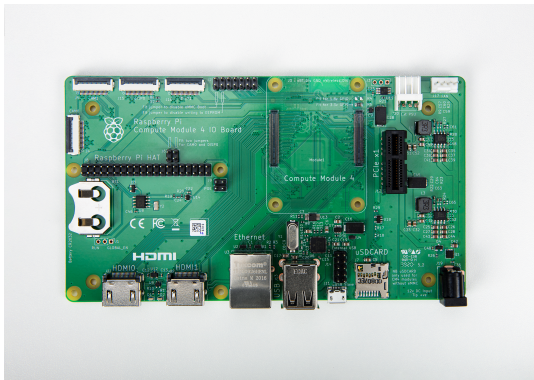




E.U. Declaration of Conformity

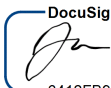
